



The PANAFCON Study Abroad Program – RWANDA Immersion (10 Days)

Student Program Fees

Track A – \$3,200	Track B – \$3,700
Includes all items below	Includes everything in Track A plus: - Accommodation outside Kigali for two nights - Specialized scientific fieldwork equipment - Additional natural science excursions

Fee Includes:

- **Full program administration & coordination**
- **Local ground transportation** (airport transfers, daily site visits, excursions)
- **Student accommodation** (shared dormitory style in Kigali; Track B field lodging outside Kigali)
- **Meals:** 3 meals/day (breakfast, lunch, dinner)
- **Local educators/facilitators** for workshops, cultural and STEM sessions
- **Entrance fees** for all scheduled sites (museums, memorials, cultural sites, biodiversity trails)
- **Fieldwork supplies** for Track B (e.g., sampling tools, notebooks, safety gear)
- **Program materials:** handouts, journaling supplies, reflection tools
- **Capstone project support:** mentorship, preparation, and presentation
- **Safety infrastructure:** first aid, local emergency protocols, supervision ratio per student
- **Cultural immersion:** music, storytelling, interaction with Rwandan youth, craft workshops
- **Recreational experiences:** light hiking, group walks, lake excursions
- **10 days of immersive learning, reflection, and meaningful engagement**



Adult / Chaperone Fee – \$975 per adult

Fee Covers:

- **Venue entrance fees** for scheduled program sites (e.g., Kigali Genocide Memorial, cultural sites, guided tours)

Note: Does **not include costs of activities inside venues** (e.g., canopy walk at Nyungwe Forest) or other optional recreational activities

- **Daily group meals, lunch excluded** (breakfast and dinner provided)
- **Ground transportation** with student group
- Participation in **welcome and closing gatherings**

Note: Adult/chaperones are responsible for accommodations unless otherwise arranged; fees do **not** cover airfare, visas, or personal expenses

Not Included (Students & Adults)

- Airfare (international or domestic)
- Visa fees and processing
- Travel or medical insurance
- Vaccinations or required medical clearances
- Personal expenses, souvenirs, or unscheduled outings
- Optional trip extensions or independent travel
